### VRSAC Equipment

We own two Rigid Inflatable boats

 $1 \times 6.00$  metres c/w  $2 \times 75$  HP 2 stoke engines  $1 \times 6.00$  metres c/w  $2 \times 50$  HP 4 stoke engines

Each boat is fitted with Radio, Echo sounder, Oxygen, life jackets for the cox's & lookout. GPS with AIS is fitted to humber rib.

The international 'A' Dive flag is always flown during diving activities.

Membership	Full diving membership - £192.50
Fees	Membership fees can either be paid by monthly standing order or by a one off payment. There is no charge for training.



	Broken down as: £55.50 BSAC Full Diving Member (28.00 BSAC for Junior Members) £68.50 Boat Fund £68.50 Branch running costs
Diving Fees	£6.00 per dive to a maximum of £12.00 per day on boat diving expeditions.
	Plus the cost of towing and fuel costs divided equally amongst the divers.
Pool Fees	Entry to swimming pool payable to Brio  A one off payment of £15.00 towards the air fills. This covers the cost of re-filling the cylinders during training activities.



Loan of Equipment	The branch is able to support trainees with pool & open water training equipment. There may be some constraints depending on numbers & and sizes.
